

### Stage 3 update

As you are aware, CSIRO is undertaking clean-up and demolition works at its Highett site to ensure the land is in a safe condition when sold.

Work on Stage 3 of the project is progressing well since our March update, a total of 17 buildings have been demolished as part of the Stage 3 works thus far. There are approximately 9 buildings left to be demolished as identified in the plan below. Work is on track and scheduled to be completed by the end of November as per our original program. CSIRO appreciates your understanding and patience while these important works are being carried out.

### Grassy woodland area

As advised in our last update, CSIRO were scheduled to meet with independent arborists engaged by Bayside City Council, this meeting

took place on site on 18th April 2018. The independent arborists inspected the grassy woodlands area and were satisfied with the measures taken to protect the area during demolition works. CSIRO were happy to report that they managed to retain all significant trees located within close proximity to buildings that were being demolished.

### Keeping you safe

CSIRO is committed to keeping its staff, contractors and the local community safe during the demolition and clean-up project. All work is being carried out in line with WorkSafe requirements and the relevant Australian standards. Water sprays are being used to manage the dust that is being produced by the demolition work. CSIRO has engaged an independent licenced asbestos assessor who will continue to monitor the removal of hazardous materials. Dust and noise monitoring devices are being used to record

environmental conditions as works progress.
